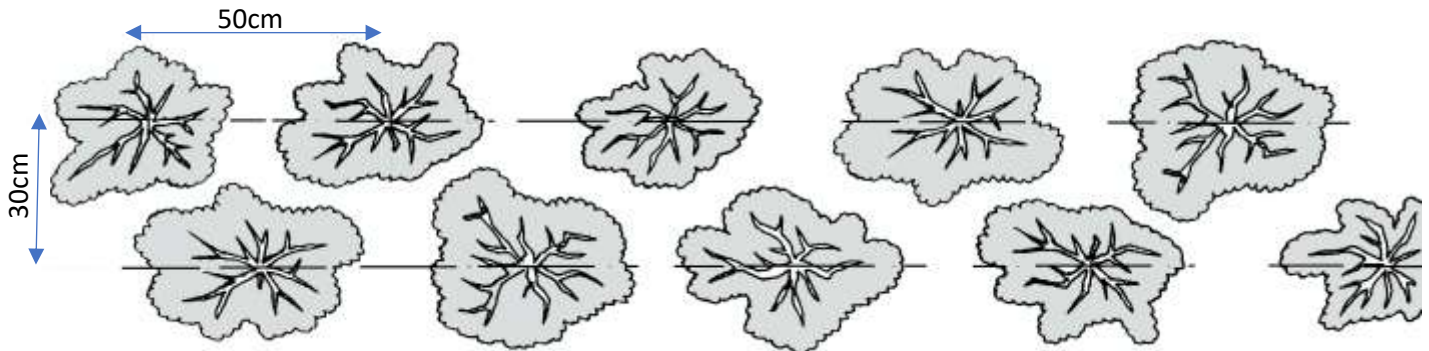

### Stock proof hedging

4 plants per metre made up of **75%** thorn and **25%** mixed species suited to your soil, position and light conditions such as Field Maple, Dogwood or Wild Privet, Hazel, Spindle, Dog Rose etc.
